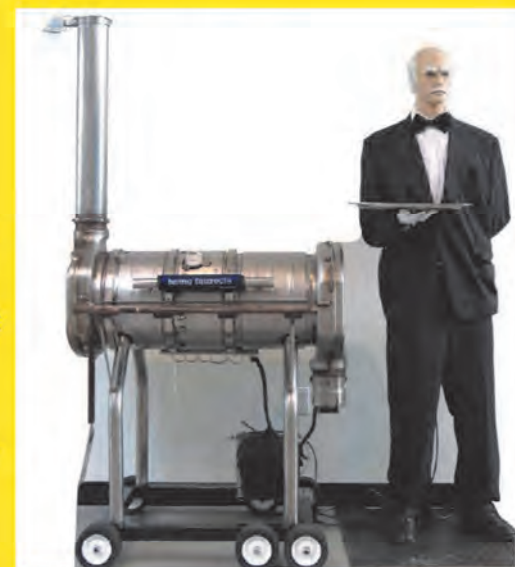
BBQ Pit

GENEROUS SUPPORT PROVIDES NEW BEDS FOR HOSPICE PATIENTS



Although the construction and initial equipping of the Hospice Center was fully paid for in 2004 by many generous individuals, corporations and foundations, ongoing maintenance of the facility and equipment puts a demand on Our Hospice and its resources.

Most of the patients served by Our Hospice of South Central Indiana reside in their homes or nursing facilities. The Hospice Center, which currently offers 14 private patient rooms with an additional 7 rooms available for expansion, meets the needs of patients experiencing critical or unresolved symptoms.

Each year, the Hospice Center has at least one significant need. In 2017, it was new patient beds.

The original beds, purchased when the facility was opened in 2004, had reached their maximum life. The family of a deceased donor became aware of the need and generously offered to provide a donation to add to grants from the Elizabeth R. and Walter C. Nugent Foundation and the Clarence E. and Inez R. Custer Foundation. Delivered on May 23, the new beds offer many important features that ensure the safety and comfort of Our Hospice patients.

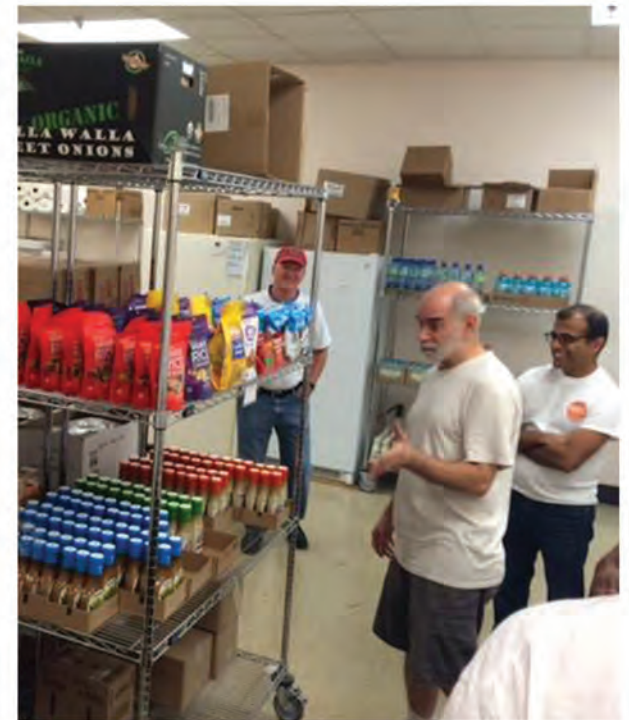
